## Definition of Terms

Cost: Neither party will pass along costs to the other party for non-transit IP traffic.

## General Terms of Service: Both parties agree to the following:

- Physical connection over the NWAX.NET exchange or as otherwise specified
- Use of TCP/IP protocol Version 4
- Use of BGP 4
- Use an RPSL database (ARIN, RADB, etc.)
- Either party may change or terminate this policy on notice of thirty days (principally a courtesy to allow for alternate arrangements to be arranged)
- Best practice of configuration and security as per CERT.ORG guidelines
- Agree to participate in resolution of any security incidents, denial of service attacks, etc.

## Limitations:

- This agreement covers only traffic between the networks listed above
- Malfunctioning networks may be disconnected temporarily
- Route Flap Dampening (RFD) may be used.
- Should peering take place at more than one interface and location, both parties agree to advertise the same routes in all the relevant places.
- Default routes of any sort between the parties of this agreement are prohibited
- Artificially changing next hop information is prohibited
