



## OHSU concludes business operations for NWAX.NET

Effective 2/15/14, OHSU concludes all business operations for the NorthWest Access Exchange (NWAX.NET) which is being handed off to NWAX, INC a 501.c.6 membership organization. After this point, all liability for NWAX resides with the new organization.


All NWAX related contracts at OHSU have been terminated, and any ongoing costs for NWAX as a cooperative business have either terminated or transitioned to the new organization. (Note that the OHSU-PSU PREN Partnership remains in full force separately from NWAX.)

NWAX, INC. has addressed maintenance contracts for network hardware.


NWAX, INC. has addressed minor equipment and operational supplies.
